## Ornamental Grasses

Ornamental grasses provide lasting beauty and make excellent additions to an established perennial garden. While most gardeners don't have just grasses planted together they do enjoy incorporating them into their garden schemes where they will make a statement. Taller grasses such as plume grass or some of the variegated grasses show up best when planted as specimen plants. Other grasses like feather reed or fescues look best when planted in groups of 3 to 5.

Grasses have varied diverse uses. They can be used to enhance the formality of a public garden or add depth to a nature planting. They are divided into 2 groups. Running grasses spread by rhizomes, which are underground stems, or by stolons, above ground horizontal stems. Running grasses can become invasive in small gardens, but they can provide erosion control in hillsides or embankments. The other group of grasses are clump forming. These grasses do well in gardens with annuals and perennials, and are easily grown in gardens where space allocation is a problem.

Grasses are further divided into cool season and warm season. Cool season grasses grow best in cooler climates and in this area it means that they will start growing in spring as the soil starts to warm up. Examples are blue oat grass (*helictotrichon*) and variegated manna (*glyceria*). Warm grasses lie dormant until soil temperatures warm up considerably, usually in late spring to early summer. They are usually fast growing so they can achieve their large sizes by autumn. Switch grass (*panicum*) and plume grass (*erianthus*) are examples of these.

Grasses also are available in many different heights. From the giant plume grass (12-20 ft) to the smaller blue fescue (8-10 in).

Large plants make excellent screens and provide areas for wildlife to hide or nest. Small grasses provide groundcover and erosion control.

Grasses have different textures and colors. Flowering plumes change from season to season emerging in white and beiges becoming red or orange in early autumn then changing to grays, and browns to provide winter color to the stark barren landscape. They are ever changing, some even introducing the element of sound into the landscape by the rustling of their leaf blades and plumes.

Ornamental grasses offer a great diversity of form, texture, color, height and growing sites. One of the most important is the place where you will be planting it. Most grasses prefer a sunny site. There are a few that will grow in shady areas. These are usually the shorter grasses like the sedges. All in all there is surely an ornamental grass that will meet your needs and provide an interesting focal point in your garden or landscape for many years. Stop by the nursery and check out our grass selection. These plants will create and heighten the interest of almost any landscape setting.

Most ornamental grasses are pest-free and other than a yearly pruning in mid March, require very little maintenance.
